HOW TO START A TUNISIAN SQUARE

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


PROCEDURE

Magic circle



Insert in magic circle



Pull up a loop



Yarn over and Pull through 1 loop



Repeat until 8 loops on the hook



Place Stitch marker in first loop



Slide to the other hook and turn your work



Take second color on your hook



Pull through 1 loop



The rest of the return pass stitches is Pull Through 2 loops!

Until you finish your work.




Pull Through 2 loops until you have 4 loops on the hook



Slide your stitches to the other hook

Turn your work

Close magic loop



Insert in first stitch from right to left and from front to back (TKS).



Pull up a loop



INCREASES

Make an increase. Insert hook between 2 vertical bars (see second hook)



Make another TKS and Increase
7 loops on the hook



Turn your work and slide the stitches



Make the Return Stitches (PT 2 loops) untils you have 5 loops on the hook



Turn your work and pick up loops again until you reach the last stitch before the marker. You have made 15 stitches in this round.



Turn and slide your work and continue with the Return Stitches on a regular base.



Turn and slide your work



CORNERS

Insert hook in first stitch (TKS) and pull up a loop



Yarn Over




Insert Hook (TKS) in same Stitch (see second hook on the photo)




Pull up a loop



Place stitch marker in the Yarn Over you made





Be Carefull on the Return Pass, Make sure that the YO stays in the middle. The YO is longer then the other stitches (see photo)



Make 3 TKS and then the second corner. All the corners are the same (TKS, YO, TKS). Place a stitch marker in the YO. Use for the 3 other corners the same color then the first one!



Make 3 TKS and the third corner.




Make 3 TKS and the last corner



Make 2 TKS in the next stitches.

Make 1 TKS in the first stitch of the first corner before the first stitch marker (see second hook on the photo)



From here you need a pattern. This is what I used to create this square. You need to make the chart 4 times for every row

I used the TKS and the TRS. The TRS is worked on the backside in the vertical back bar like a TSS. By working on the back your second color will appear on the front of your work.

SHORT EXPLANATION OF TRS

Move you're your towards so you can see the back of your work, insert your hook from right to left and pull up a loop.
