## WINTER CAL - PART BORDERS

TUNISIAN CROCHET IN THE ROUND


This is the last part of the CAL. We are going to make the border. I choose to make a Honey Comb border because I love the look of this very beautiful stitch. It is simple, but it looks great especially in Tunisian in the Round.

## PATTERN

This is a small part of the border Just to give you an idea how to handle.



## FOUNDATION ROUND

You start at one of the corners with a corner (TKS/YO/TKS). Pick up loops like you made TRS. This way the Bind Off Row of the squares stay visible. Pick up a loop in every stitch of the squares. I did not pick up a loop between the squares, but you have to see if that is also good for your work.


## ROUND 2

Before and after every corner you need to pick up 1 TKS to hide the spiral-look.
Make a corner, 1 TKS , *1 TPS / 1 TSS* repeat the 2 stitches until you reach the corner of the previous row. Make a TKS in the TKS of the previous row/corner. Corner(TKS/YO/TKS) in the YO of the previous row, TKS in the TKS of the previous row/corner.

Repeat this 3 times for every row.
Of course you can add more rows if you like.

KEEP THE STITCHES OF THE CORNERS LINED UP CORRECTLY OR ELSE YOU WILL NEED TO FROG A COMPLETE ROUND

## BINDING OFF

Work all the stitches of the last round, DO NOT make a new corner. Turn your work and make ALL the Return Pass stitches, 1 loop left on the hook.

Use color 1 for the Bind Off Row and the hook you used for the Forward Pass (I remove the cable from my hook before binding off).

- Make only 1 slipstitch on the corners
- Make a Bind Off Stitch (slipstitch) in every stitch
- When you have worked all the stitches, close the row with a slipstitch in the first slipstitch (to hide the last return stitch)
