
This week there will be 5 blocks on the programm. It seems like a lot but it is much less stitches then last week; p there are no less then 3 small blocks in. With the 2 larger blocks I will show you how you can play with the stitches. This time you won't learn new stitches.

#### **Used stitches**

TSS Tunisian Simple Stitch
TKS Tunisian Knit Stitch
TPS Tunisian Purl stitch

TTKS Tunisian Twisted Knit Stitch

Crosstitch see explanation week 2



Block 10 10x10 Color B

Block 10 will be crochet on block 9 and next to block 8. Count 20 stitches from right of on block 9 and attach your thread into the 21st stitch.

# Technique

This block will be crochet completly in TKS.

If it is crochet to tight then take a crochethook larger! **BUT WATCH OUT!!! Make sure that the first stitch won't be to broad because then you get big holes in your work.** 

You even can crochet an additional row, as I've done here. Remember that otherwise you will not match with the block what is next to come to it.



Block 11 20x20 Color B

Designer: Mouse

The middle section of this block you might also use the rib stitch very well with a cardigan or a sweater.

Block 11 will be crochet on block 4 and 6, next to block 5 and 9. On block 9 you are counting 10 rows and place there a stitchmarker. Count 20 stitches of the right upper corner of block 6 and attach your thread to the 21st stitch and crochet in this also your first stitch.

#### **Used stitches**

TTKS Tunisian Twisted Knit Stitch

TPS Tunisian Purl Stitch

Rib Stitch

#### Rib

Crochet 2 TTKS,\*2 TPS, 2TTKS\* repeat \* \*for the remaining stitches of the row

#### **Return pass**

No details so not taken on in the schema.

# Technique

Crochet the foundation row

## Row 2 and 3

Crochet these 2 rows in TKS.

# Row 4 and 5

Crochet these rows in TPS

## Row 6 and 7

Crochet these rows in TKS

## **Rows 8 to 14**

Crochet the rib stitch (see explanation)

# Rows 15 to 20

Repeat row 2 to row 7

Tie-offrow



# Block 12 10x10 Color A

Block 12 will be next to block 11 onto block 6. **Count 10 stitches, from the right upper corner of block 6 and attach your thread into the 11th stitch**. Count on block 10 rows out and place your stitchmarker.

# **Technique**

Crochet the complet block in TSS

Block 13 10x10 Color D

Block 13 will be crochet on block 12 and next to block 11. Attach your thread tot he right upper corner of block 12.

# **Technique**

Crochet the complet block in TTKS.



Block 14 20x20 Color A

Designer: Mouse

# Use a hooksize larger!

This block will be crochet next to block 6. Attach your thread to the right LOWERcorner and crochet a chain of 20. Turn your chain and crochet the foundation row.

TSS Tunisian Simple Stitch
Crosstitch (explanations week 3)

## **Return pass**

The return pass has no details and is therefor not taken on into the counting pattern

# Technique

Crochet the foundation row.

Row 2 and 3 Crochet completly in TSS

Row 4 to 18 Crochet everything normal in Crosstitch

Row 19 and 20 Crochet completly in TSS
