


Discover the Seasons - week 5

This week there will be 3 blocks to crochet. This time no designs of me, but from Manon Geijtenbeek-Nieuwenhuis. And that is not the only thing new, but there will be a new stitch.

But we start with another small block of 10x10



Block 15**10x10****Color C**

This will be made on block 14 and next to block 16. Count 10 stitches from the right topcorner of block 14. Attach in the 11th stitch and make your first stitch here.

This block is in TPS tunisian purl stitch

This block will be made on block 6 and 15, next to block 12 and 13. Attach your yarn on top of the right corner of block 15

Stitches

I TSS Tunisian Simple Stitch

↓ TRS Tunisian Reverse Stitch

Explanation TRS

This a new stitch, so when you are smart you first make a swatch . The TRS is like the TSS, but you work on the backside of your work! Watch out that you pick up the righth stitch! You work from right to left on the backside of your work. You pick up the backpost from the stitch and pull through. (it is a tss on the backside of your work)

Chart

the return pass is standard

Make the foundation row

Row 2 thru 5

Crochet in TSS

Row 6 thru 9

Crochet in TRS

Row 10 thru 13

Crochet in TSS

Row 14 thru 20

Repeat row 6 thru 13


Playing with stitches! All the used Stitches are known, but look how easy it is to play with your stitches. It is just like normal crochet, you combine the basics and you get amazing patterns. You could use these in a sweater.

This block will be made on block 8 and 10. Attach at the top af the right corner of block 10.

Make the foundation row

Row 2 thru 5

5 stitches TKS, 5 stitches TPS, repeat * * twice.

Row 7 thru 10

5 stitches TPS, 5 stitches TKS, repeat * * twice.

Row 11 thru toer 30

Herhaal toer 2 thru 10

I did the closing row in TPS
