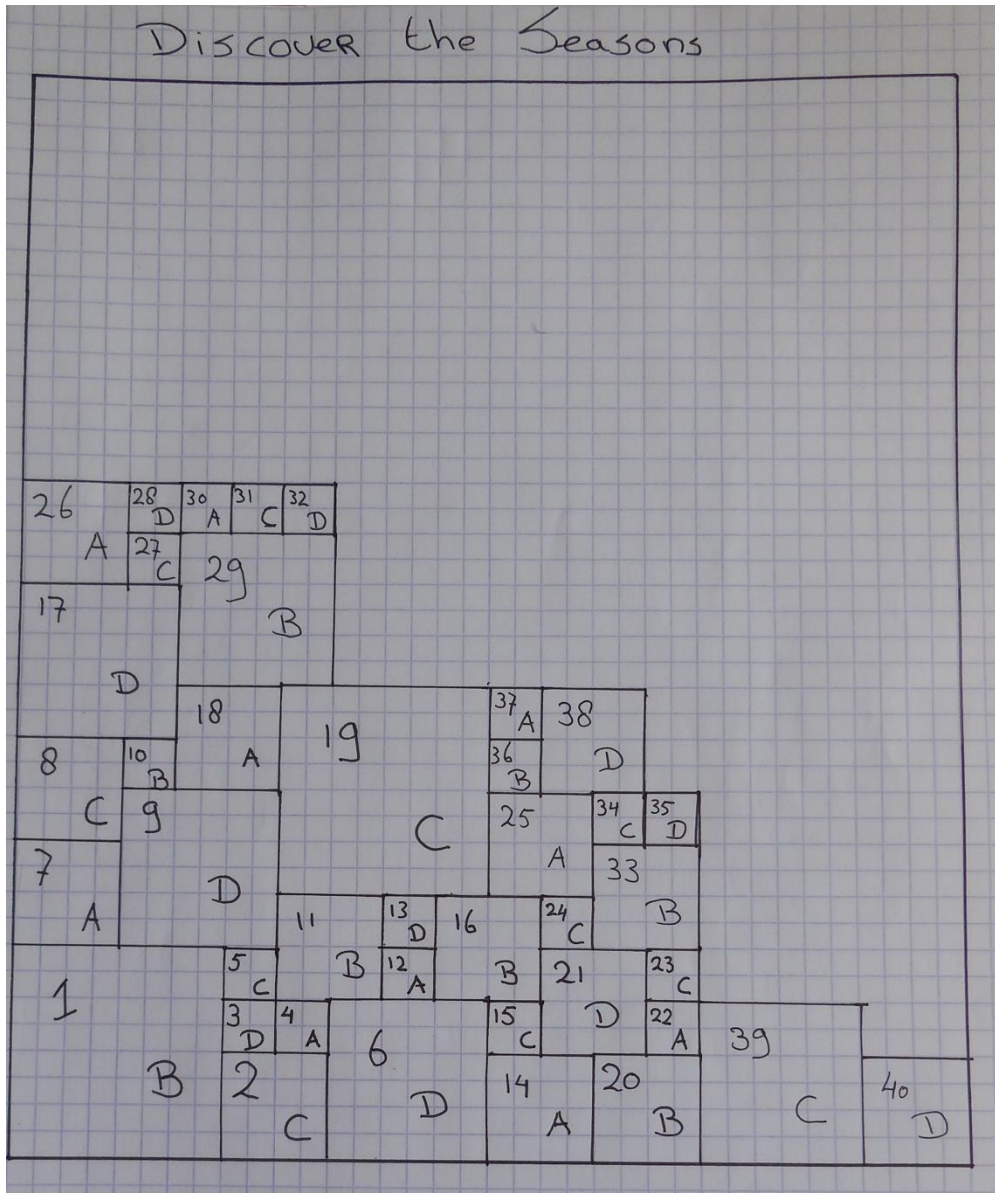


## Discover the Seasons – week 10

## Description

Make the foundation row

### Row 2

Crochet tss, \*Yarn over, skip 1 stitch, tss\*, repeat \* \* until 1 stitch left, tss

### Row 3

Crochet 2 tss, yarn over, 1 tss on chain of the previous row\*, repeat \* \*until 1 stitch left, tss

### Row 4 thru 20

repeat row 2 and 3



**Block 39**                      **30stx23rows!!!**                      **color C**

This block will be made next to block 20 and 22. Attach on the right lower corner of block 20 en chain 30. Make your foundation row.

**Explanation TDS**

Step 1 Yarn over,

Step 2 Pick up the next stitch, yarn over and pull through 1 loop

Step 3 Yarn over and pull through 2 loops

**Used Patterns**Honeycomb      **tps, tss, tps** next row **tss,tps, tss**

Starstitch      make 3 TDS on 3 stitches together

## **Explanation**

Make the foundation row

### **Row 2 - 5**

Honeycomb

Row 2                1 TSS, 1 tps, 1 tss etc

Row 3                1 TPS, 1 tss, 1 tss etc

Repeat row 2 and 3

### **Row 6**

**start** the row with **a chain!!!** Completely in TDS

Step 1    Yarn over,

Step 2    Pick up the next stitch, yarn over and pull through 1 loop

Step 3    Yarn over and pull through 2 loops

Repeat the 3 steps

**ATTENTION!!** SKIP 1 ROW OF BLOCK 20 WHEN ATTACHING! This is necessary because of the height of the TDS.

### **Row 7 and 8**

Starstitch in TDS.

#### **Step 1                crochet 1 chain**

step 2                Yarn over

step 3                pick up 3 stitches, yarnover and pull through 3 loops

step 4                Yarn over and pull through 2 loops on the hook

step 5                Yarn over

step 6                pick up the same 3 stitches, yarnover and pull through 3 loops

step 7                Yarn over and pull through 2 loops on the hook

step 8                repeat step 5-7 1 more time

repeat step 2 - 8 until the end of the row.

**ATTENTION!!** SKIP 1 ROW OF BLOCK 20 WHEN ATTACHING! This is necessary because of the height of the TDS.

Foundation Row

### **Row 2**

completely in TKS

#### **return pass**

- Step 1            4 times through 2 loops
- Step 2            pull through 1 loop(chain)
- Step 3            pull through **4 loops**(3 stitches together)
- Step 4            pull through 1 loop(chain)
- Step 5            2 times through 2 loops
- Step 6            repeat 2 times step 2 - 5
- Step 7            2 times through 2 loops

### **Row 3 thru 19**

3 TKS, \* TKS on chain, TKS on Custer, TKS on chain, 2 TKS\*, repeat \* \* 2 times, 2TKS

When attaching on block 39 remember that you have to attach 2 rows in the rows of the tds and the starstitch
