
# **Discover the Seasons – week 16**

# <u>Block 61 20x20 color D</u>

design: Carla

This Block will be made on block 55/57 and next to 49/56. count 20 stitche from the right top corner and attach your yarn in the  $21^{st}$  stitch.

step 6	TSS

## Read all instructions!!! Follow the step by step instructions!!!

We are going to make cables, cables like you see in knitting. We are going to cross stitches but not like the crossitch. The crossing will be done in the return pass!! It is best when you use a stitch holder, but it can also be done with a crochet hook.

This block will be made on block 59/60 and next to 57/62. Attach your yarn on the rigth top corner of block 60.

### **Explanation Cable**

cable to the left

You're making the cables in the return pass

step 1	pull 5 loops of the hook. The first loop is your working loop, make this one larger and leave it
step 2	pick up your stitch holder and pick up the loops which are close to your hook. Lay stitch holder in
	front of your work
step 3	pick up the other 2 stitches with your crochet hook
step 4	pick up the loops from the stitch holder onto your crochet hook
step 5	pick up your working loop and make it normal size
step 6	pull through 2 loops on the hook
step 7	pull through 1 loop on the hook(a chain to give the cable some room)
step 8	pull through 2 loops on the hook

# Cable to the right

You're making the cables in the return pass

- step 1 pull 5 loops of the hook. The first loop is your working loop, make this one larger and leave it
- step 2 pick up your stitch holder and pick up the loops which are close to your hook. Lay the stitch holder at **the backside** of your work
- step 3 pick up the other 2 stitches with your crochet hook
- step 4 pick up the loops from the stitch holder onto your crochet hook
- step 5 pick up your working loop and make it normal size
- step 6 pull through 2 loops on the hook
- step 7 pull through 1 loop on the hook(a chain to give the cable some room)
- step 8 pull through 2 loops on the hook

# If you're working on the odd rows make sure the TKS are not to tight!! Take a look at the youtube movie of Kim Guzman. Allthough she works with 6 stitches, it is the same.
