
Discover the Seasons – week 19

This weekend something complete new technique. Block 77 is a mitered square. I included a step by step photo instruction. Just keep on counting stitches. The rest is simple to make.



Block 74 10x10 color B

This block will be made on block 72 next to block 70. Count 10 stitches from the right top corner of block 72 and attach in the 11^{th} stitch.

Completely in TKS Tunisian Knit Stitch

Block 75 10x10 color C

This block will be made on block 74 next to block 71. Attach at the right top corner of block 74

Completely in TPS Tunisian Purl Stitch



Block 76 20x20 color D

design: Muis inspired by a knitting pattern

This block will be made on block 72/73 next to block 74/75. Count 10 stitches from the right top corner of block 73 and attach in the 11th stitch.



Description

Follow the Chart



Existing: Mittered Square

Kim Guzman has a great YouTube movie of this pattern in English. There is also a pattern on Ravelry and our David Coleman has made a beautiful blanket of mitered squares.

This block will be made on block 75/76 and next to block 71. Count 10 stiches from the right top corner of block 76 and attach in the 11th stitch.

Stitch

Completely in TSS Tunisian Simple Stitch

Start with the forward pass, take care that you have 21 loops on the hook! DO NOT START THE RETURN PASS!! We continue picking up loops for the foundation row. Loop 22 is in the same loop where you tied off block 75. Place a stitch marker on this loop.

Turn your work and pick up 21 loops on the site of block 71.



Now you have 43 loops on the hook.

Start your return pass. First pull through 1 loop and pull through 2 loops **UNTIL 1 loop before** the loop with the stitch marker.

Now we are going to **crochet 3 stitches together**(the loop with the marker, 1 in the front of it and 1 after). You have to pull through 4 loops on the hook. The rest of the return pass is standard(pull through 2 loops)



Row 2
Pick up loops(TSS) and at the middle stitch you make 1 stitch on the cluster



Pick up loops until the end of the row. Start the return pass UNTIL 1 LOOP BEFORE the stitch on the cluster.



Again we are going to **crochet 3 stitches together**(the loop with the marker, 1 in the front of it and 1 after). You have to pull through 4 loops on the hook. The rest of the return pass is standard(pull through 2 loops)

You have to repeat this every row. Because you decrease every row 2 stitches you will create a square

Keep on going until you have only 3 loops on the hook at the end of the forward pass



Pull through 1 loop on the hook and pull through the remaining stitches at the same time. Make a slip stitch in the last stitch and tie off.

CHECK FREQUENTLY IF BOTH SIDES HAVE EQUAL NUMBER OF STITCHES!!

It is no problem, when your square has a point at the last corner, when you attach the next block it is gone.



Block 78 10x10 color A

This block will be made on block 73 next to block 76. Attach at the right top corner of block 73

Block 79 10x10 color C

This block will be made on block 78 next to block 76. Attach at the right top corner of block 78

Completely in in TPS Tunisian Purl Stitch
