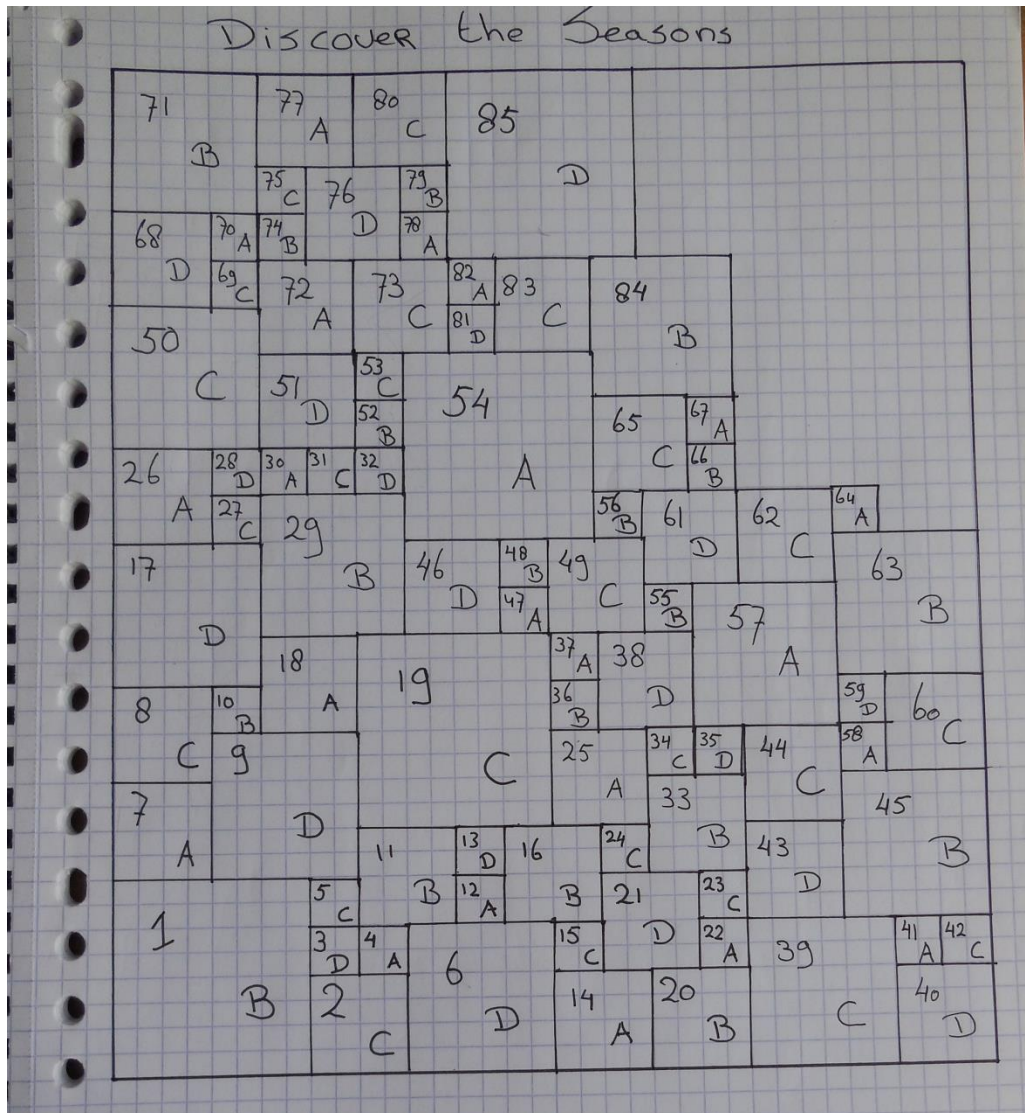


## Discover the Seasons week 21

This week only 2 blocks but they are large blocks. The first one is a nice one with 2 flowers made with cables and is based on a knitting pattern. The second one is a pattern which you will find in The Tunisian crochet stitch guide by Kim Guzman. Just because I liked it so much.



## **Block 84**                      **30x30**                      **color B**

Design: Muis inspired by a knitting pattern

This block will be made on block 65/67 and next to block 54/83. Attach at the right top corner of block 67

	TSS
	TPS tunisian purl stitch/ tunische averechtse steek
	TKS tunisian knit stitch/ tunische breisteek
	return stitch/terugsteek
	kabel naar links
	kabel naar rechts
	3 double crochet together/ 3 stokjes samenhaken

Kabel naar links translation cable to the left

Kabel naar rechts translation cable to the right

### **Explanation Cable**

#### **Cable to the left**

You're making the cables in the return pass

- step 1                      pull **3 loops** off the hook. The first loop is your working loop, make this one larger and leave it
- step 2                      pick up your stitch holder and pick up the loop which is close to your hook. Lay stitch holder in **front** of your work
- step 3                      pick up the other stitch with your crochet hook
- step 4                      pick up the loop from the stitch holder onto your crochet hook
- step 5                      pick up your working loop and make it normal size
- step 6                      pull through 2 loops on the hook
- step 7                      pull through 1 loop on the hook(a chain to give the cable some room)
- step 8                      pull through 2 loops on the hook

#### **Cable to the right**

You're making the cables in the return pass

- step 1                      pull 3 loops off the hook. The first loop is your working loop, make this one larger and leave it
- step 2                      pick up your stitch holder and pick up the loop which is close to your hook. Lay the stitch holder at **the backside** of your work
- step 3                      pick up the other stitch with your crochet hook
- step 4                      pick up the loops from the stitch holder onto your crochet hook
- step 5                      pick up your working loop and make it normal size
- step 6                      pull through 2 loop on the hook
- step 7                      pull through 1 loop on the hook(a chain to give the cable some room)
- step 8                      pull through 2 loop on the hook

**Keep track on all stitches when you do the next row, a stitch is hidden under each cable stitch!**

**If you're working on the rows under the cables make sure the TKS are not to tight!! Take a look at the you tube movie of Kim Guzman. Although she works with 6 stitches, it is the same.**

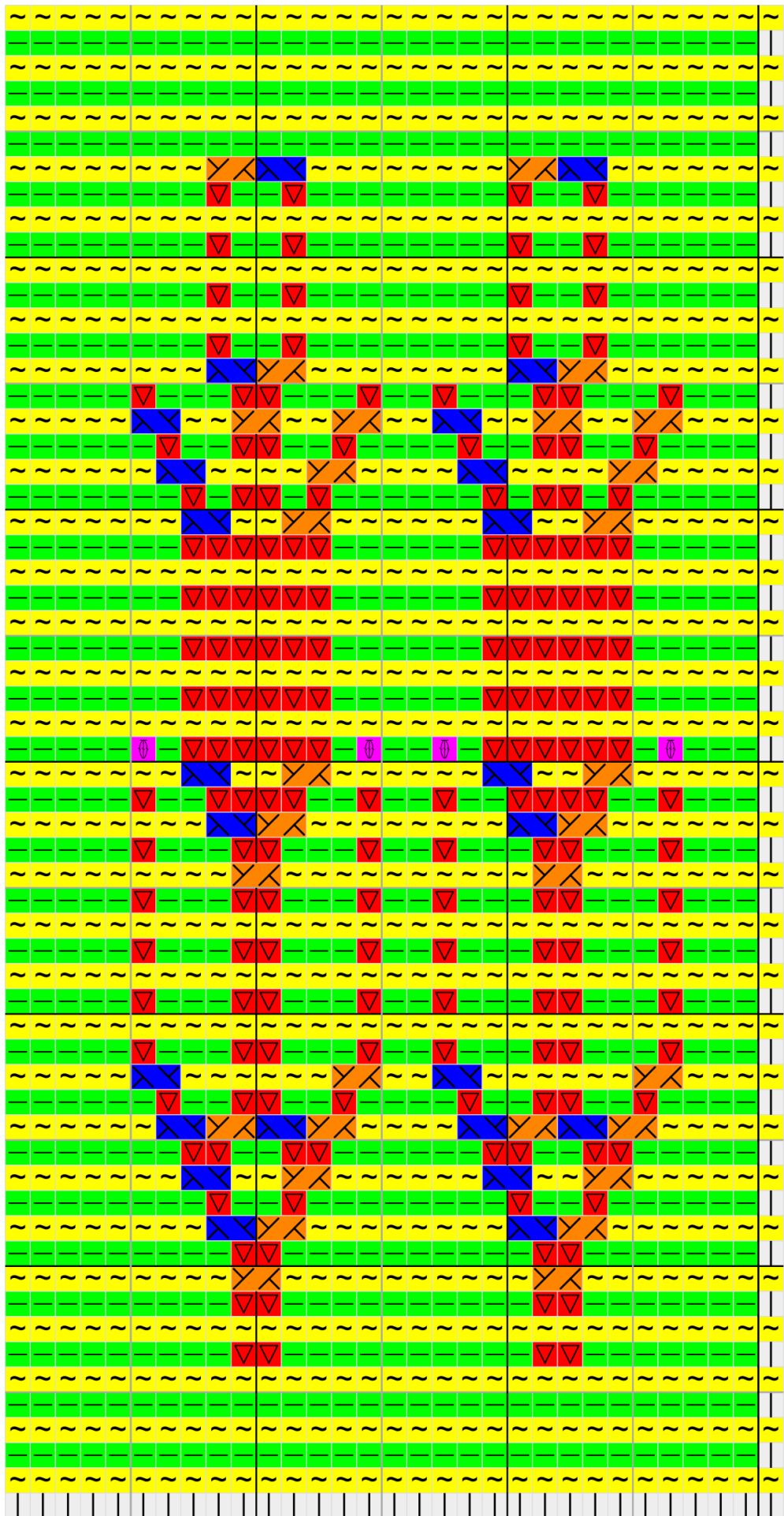

## Description

Follow the chart. The explanation of the cables is above the chart. You make cables with 2 stitches. If you work carefull you can work without a stitch holder. But be carefull that you won't loose the second loop.

**The TKS is always in the front of your work.**

There will be a new stitch a cluster of 3 double crochet together(also known as bobble stitch). That will work as follows

- step 1 Yarnover
- step 2 Insert your hook like a tks
- step 3 yarn over and pull through
- step 4 Yarn over and pull through 2 loops on the hook
- step 5 Insert your hook like a tks in **the same stitch**
- step 6 yarn over and pull through
- step 7 Yarn over and pull through 2 loops on the hook
- step 8 Insert your hook like a tks in **the same stitch**
- step 9 yarn over and pull through
- step 10 Yarn over and pull through 2 loops on the hook
- step 11 **Yarn over and pull through 3 loops on the hook!!!!**





## Block 85 40x40 color D

Design by Kim Guzman

Do not work too loose!!



This block will be made on block 82/83/84 and next to block 78/79/80. Count 20 stitches from the right top corner of block 84 and attach in the 21<sup>st</sup> stitch

### Stitches

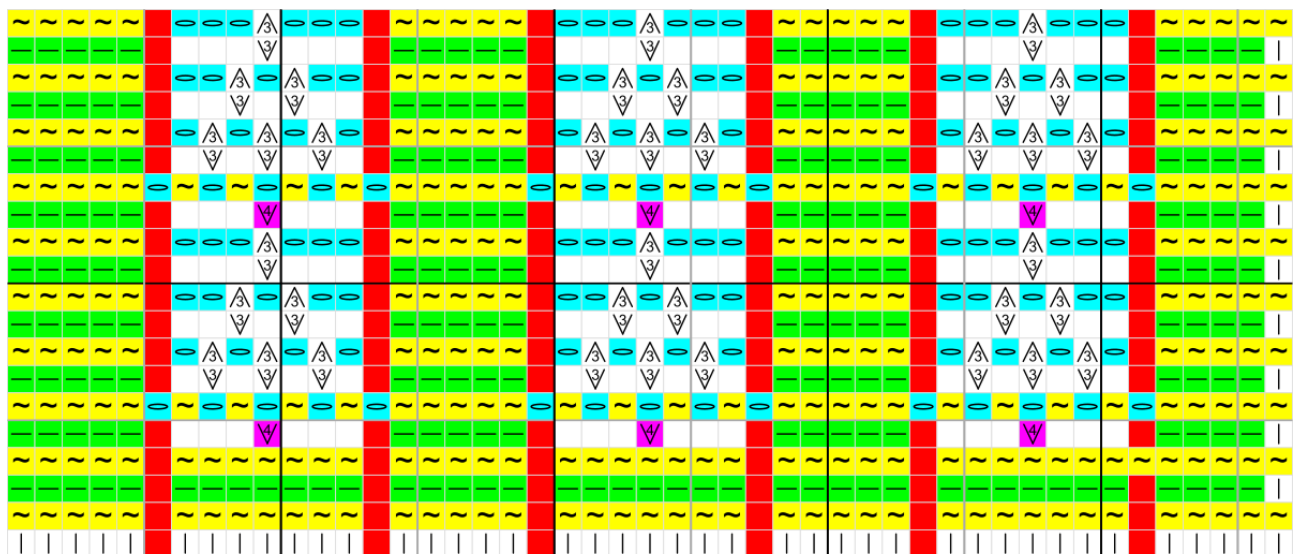
**Attention!!!!!!**

**In this chart are red columns. NO stitches will be made there!!!!!!**

Look close to the explanation of the stitches!! And read the instructions carefully!!!

	skip this stitch / sla deze steek over
	TPS tunisian Purl Stitch / averechtse steek
	TSS, yarn over, TSS on the chain / TSS, omslag, TSS op losse
	return stitch / terugsteek
	chain 1 / 1 losse
	3 stitches together(pull through 4 loops) / 3 steken samenhalen(haal door 4 lussen)
	TSS tunisian simple stitch / TSS tunische steek
	no Stitch / geen steek
	skip stitch/ steek overslaan
	4 TDS in the same stitch / 4 TDS in dezelfde steek

## Description

### **Read Careful! AND FOLLOW STEP BY STEP!!!!**

Work stitches on the chain like this: insert the hook in the chain with 2 strands on top and 1 under and pull up a loop. This method will prevent loosening the yarn in the chain

Foundation Row

### **Row 2**

TPS

### **Row 3**

**forward**

- step 1            4 **TPS**
- step 2            skip **3** stitches
- step 3            **4 TDS**(yarnover, tss, yarnover pull through 2 loops) in the **same stitch**
- step 4            skip **3** stitches
- step 5            5 **TPS**
- step 6            repeat step 2 thru 5 **twice**
- step 7            1 **TPS**

**Return**

- step 1            5 times pull through 2 loops
- step 2            pull through **1** loop(chain)
- step 3            pull through 2 loops
- step 4            repeat step 2 and 3 **3 times**
- step 5            pull through 1 loop
- step 6            5 times pull through 2 loops
- step 7            repeat step 2 thru 5 **2 times**
- step 8            5 times pull through 2 loops

### **Row 4**

**forward**

- step 1            4 **TPS**
- step 2            **3 TSS** on the chain between the TDS of the previous row(it will look like a puff-stitch)
- step 3            repeat step 2 **twice**
- step 4            5 **TPS**
- Step 5            repeat step 2 thru 4 **twice**
- step 6            5 **TPS**

**Return**

- Step 1            5 times pull through **2 loops**
- step 2            pull through **1** loop(chain)
- step 3            pull through **4** loops (3 stiches together)
- step 4            repeat step 2 and 3 **twice**
- step 5            pull through **1** loop(chain)
- step 6            5 times pull through **2 loops**
- step 7            repeat step 2 thru 6 **twice**
- step 8            5 times pull through **2 loops**

### **Row 5**

**forward**

- step 1            4 **TPS**
- step 2            **3 TSS** on the chain between the groups of TSS of the previous row(it will look like a puff-stitch)
- step 3            repeat step 2
- step 4            5 **TPS**
- Step 5            repeat step 2 thru 4 **twice**
- step 6            5 **TPS**

### **Return**

Step 1           **5** times pull through **2 loops**  
step 2           pull through **1** loop **TWICE**  
step 3           pull through **4** loops (3 stiches together)  
step 4           pull through **1** loop(chain)  
step 5           pull through **4** loops (3 stiches together)  
step 6           pull through **1** loop **TWICE**  
step 7           **5** times pull through **2 loops**  
step 8           repeat step 2 thru 7 **twice**  
step 9           **5** times pull through **2 loops**

### **Row 6**

#### **forward**

step 1           **4 TPS**  
step 2           **3 TSS** on the chain between the groups of TSS of the previous row(it will look like a puff-stitch)  
step 3           **5 TPS**  
Step 4           repeat step 2 and 3 **twice**  
step 5           **5 TPS**

### **Return**

Step 1           **5** times pull through **2 loops**  
step 2           pull through **1** loop **3 times**  
step 3           pull through **4** loops (3 stiches together)  
step 4           pull through **1** loop **3 times**  
step 5           **5** times pull through **2 loops**  
step 6           repeat step 2 thru 5 **twice**  
step 7           **5** times pull through **2 loops**

### **Row 7**

#### **forward**

step 1           **4 TPS**  
step 2           skip **3** stitches  
step 3           **4 TDS**(yarnover, tss, yarnover pull through 2 loops) on the cluster of row 6  
step 4           skip **3** stitches  
step 5           **5 TPS**  
step 6           repeat step 2 thru 5 **twice**  
step 7           **1 TPS**

### **Return**

step 1           **5** times pull through **2 loops**  
step 2           pull through **1** loop(chain)  
step 3           pull through **2** loops  
step 4           repeat step 2 and 3 **3 times**  
step 5           pull through **1** loop  
step 6           **5** times pull through **2 loops**  
step 7           repeat step 2 thru 5 **2 times**  
step 8           **5** times pull through **2 loops**

### **Row 8 thru 38**

repeat row 4 thru 7

### **Row 39**

Completely in TPS, also on all of the chain of 38

Work stitches on the chain like this: insert the hook in the chain with 2 strands on top and 1 under and pull up a loop.  
This method will prevent loosening the yarn in the chain

### **Row 40**

Completely TPS

binding off
