

Shawl of Muis – Week 1

The Shawl of Muis is a design of Marjolein Kooiman

Size 100cm by 240cm

Materials

13 skeins of 50 grams/112mtr hook 3-4 (I used Scheepjes Donna)

7 skeins of color 1

6 skeins of color 2

Hook 5.0mm with a cable of 80-100cm. I used knitpro with an 80cm cable

Hook 5.5mm with a cable of 80-100cm. I used knitpro with an 80cm cable

Stitch marker

You need to know the basics of Tunisian crochet before you start with this shawl. The basics will not be explained in this Cal.

Basic instruction

You need to increase on every row. I used a yarn over, or you could insert a stitch in the chain or use a TFS. You increase at 4 places in the forward pass; after the first stitch, in front of the last stitch and on both sides of the middle stitch.

The first few rows are explained step by step, the increases will not be mentioned during the rest of the pattern, but you have to do it in every single row

The return is standard (pull through 1 loop and the rest pull through 2 loops). The last 3 rows are different, and will be explained in the pattern.

The middle stitch is always a TSS!!

Color changes (CC)

Forward pass

When CC is at the beginning of the row, you pull through the last 2 loops of the return pass of the previous row with the new color.

Return pass

When CC is at the beginning of the return passes, you pull through 1 loop with the new color

USING 3 COLORS

The testers of my shawl asked me if there was a possibility to make the shawl in 3 colors. So I made a color chart with 2 options for the use of 3 colors. The differences are marked in red

Pattern

Chain 5

Row 1

Insert into the of 2nd chain from hook and each chain across (5 loops), and do the return pass (pull through 1 loop, then 2 loops the rest of the row).

Row 2

Stitches

Explanation

Step 1 Skip the first stitch at the side (1 loop at the hook)
Step 2 **Increase** (2 loops at the hook)
Step 3 Make a TSS (Tunisian simple stitch) on the second stitch (3 loops at the hook)
Step 4 **Increase** (4 loops at the hook)
Step 5 Make a TSS (Tunisian simple stitch) on the stitch in the middle (5 loops at the hook)
Step 6 **Increase** (6 loops at the hook)
Step 7 Make a TSS (Tunisian simple stitch) on the 4th stitch (7 loops at the hook)
Step 8 **Increase** (8 loops at the hook)
Step 9 Make a TSS (Tunisian simple stitch) on the 5th stitch (9 loops at the hook)

Make the return pass (pull through 1 loop and the rest pull through 2 loops)

Row 3

The stitches at the side and in the middle stay the same. The middle stitch is always a TSS (Tunisian simple stitch)

Explanation

- Steps 1 Skip the first stitch at the side (1 loop at the hook)
- Step 2 **Increase** (2 loops at the hook)
- Step 3 TPS (3 loops at the hook)
- Step 4 TSS (4 loops at the hook)
- Step 5 TPS (5 loops at the hook)
- Step 6 **Increase** (6 loops at the hook)
- Step 7 TSS (7 loops at the hook)
- Step 8 **Increase** (8 loops at the hook)
- Step 9 TPS (9 loops at the hook)
- Step 10 TSS (10 loops at the hook)
- Step 11 TPS (11 loops at the hook)
- Step 12 **Increase** (12 loops at the hook)
- Step 13 TSS (13 loops at the hook)

Make the return pass (pull through 1 loop and the rest pull through 2 loops)

Row 4

(17 loops)

Honey Comb

- | TSS Tunisian simple stitch
- TPS Tunisian purl stitch
- Increase (yarn over or TSS in chain)

Always start with an increase, increase in front of the middle stitch and right after the middle stitch an Increase and increase before the last stitch you also make an Increase.

Attention

When you have made the increase after the middle stitch, you have to start with the same stitch you did right in front of the middle stitch (before the increase) This makes the 2 sides mirror images.



Row 5 thru 20

Honey Comb.

Start every row with a TPS (purl stitch), and the pattern comes automatically.

Row 21

Honey Comb. The return pass is in color 2,(your first pull through 1 loop is in color 2)
Do not cut the yarn, just leave it hanging, as we pick it up again for the next return pass

Because of the odd number of stitches you need to make an extra increase each side for the next section.

Follow pattern with usual increases. However, after 20 loops, increase again, and after 70 loops another increase.

(87 loops)

Cross stitch

Use a larger hook on the Crosstitch

Skip the first stitch, TSS in the next stitch, TSS in the skipped stitch. * **Skip the next stitch, TSS, TSS in skipped stitch** *

Repeat * * until the end of the row. Don't forget the increases.

Normal return pass with color change

Do not cut the yarn, as we pick it up again for the next return pass

Row 22 thru 25

CROSS STITCH with color changes

At the start of the return pass (pull through 1 loop) you change your color. Your last color (row 25) is color 1

Do not cut the yarn, as we pick it up again for the next return pass

(103 loops)



Row 26 thru 27

Switch back to a smaller hook

Color 1

TSS CC at the last pull through (2 loops) at the end of the return pass of **row 27**

(111 loops)

Row 28 thru 33

Horizontal stripes

CC at the last pull through (2 loops) at the end of the return pass of the TPS-row

Horizontal stripes

Row 28	TSS	color 2	
Row 29	TPS	color 2	Change color
Row 30	TSS	color 1	
Row 31	TPS	color 1	Change color
Row 32	TSS	color 2	
Row 33	TPS	color 2	Change color

(135 loops)



Row 34 thru 36

Color 1

TSS CC at the last pull through (2 loops) at the end of the return pass of row 36

(147 loops)

Row 37 thru 46

Color 2

VERTICAL STRIPES

Stitches

- **TPS** Tunisian purl stitch

∩ **TKS** Tunisian knit stitch

~ Return stitch

All of the rows are the same.

Attention!! Because of the increases, however, you start every row with the **other** stitch.

CC at the last pull through (2 loops) at the end of the return pass of **row 46**

(187 loops)



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
